COREI HALL

Age 14

Died 12th October 2023

Corei was lost to suicide in London, following targeted anti-trans hate online, predominantly through Twitter.

Even after posting about Corei's death online, his mother, Rita, was subject to trans-hostile harassment until she deleted the Tweet.

Rita has since raised over £10,000 for Corei's funeral, with remaining funds being donated to charities supporting transgender lives.

EMMA ALRAABEAH

Age 18

Died 26th June 2024

Emma died by suicide in Harlow, Essex. They were non-binary and had fled from Saudi Arabia to start a new life in the UK.

Emma was an active member of the antifa movement and participated in many protests in support of the Palestinian cause. After they died, their birth family refused to receive their body.

LEANDRO 'LEO' WALKER TITLEY

Age 21

Died 30th August 2024

Leo took his own life at the end of August this year. He had been waiting for a first appointment at an NHS gender clinic for over 2 years.

A friend of Leo said “He’s based in London, and his favourite colour is purple, [...] and he was and is genuinely one of the kindest and most generous people I know.”

Leo had created a fundraiser for his top surgery, commenting on the fact of knowing who he is for a “longggggg time”, and how “chest dysphoria is a very large part of my life”. Leo anticipated a wait of up to 12 years going through the NHS for surgery.

NATASHA REDDINGTON-ROMANOV

Age 55

Died 21st September 2024

The cause of Natasha’s death 2 months ago has not been reported. She was initially reported missing on the 24th September, last seen in London on the night of the 20th. Her body was found in the River Thames a week later.

Natasha has been described by friends as an “icon of Soho”, with one saying she seemed her usual self on the day she went missing, including discussing plans for Christmas and an upcoming event.



Further to this, there have been 453 other reports of deaths around the world of transgender people.

Many are a result of violence, suicide, negligence and some remain undetermined.
